LEGAL TECHNOLOGY PLATFORM INITIATIVE (LTPI)



The LTPI is a key initiative under the Ministry of Law's ("MinLaw") Technology and Innovation Roadmap. It supports Singapore law firms to kickstart their digitalisation journey through three key thrusts:

The Legal Technology Platform (LTP), a matter management and collaboration tool co-developed by MinLaw and its technology partner Lupl. The LTPI Funding Programme to defray the initial costs of adopting the LTP and solutions integrated

Ongoing Industry Engagement to continuously test and provide feedback on the LTP.








Benefits of the LTP

- Streamlines and tracks your legal workflows to help you focus on more substantive legal work
- Consolidates information and correspondences in a single view
- Coordinates your legal work across platforms (e.g. email, Slack and WhatsApp)
- Manages your firm's knowledge and precedents using the built-in matter templates
- Enhances your access to key features of existing Legal Tech tools (e.g. Tessaract, Clio, TessaCloud, NetDocuments)
- Enhances your access to digital systems by public agencies and the Singapore Courts (e.g. ACRA, eLitigation, Sign with SingPass, and more to come)

How was the LTP developed? How secure is it?

- The LTP was developed after consulting over 100 lawyers from small and medium Singapore law firms
- An Industry Engagement and Advisory Group (IEAG) comprising early LTP adopters will continuously test and provide feedback
- The LTP incorporates the security and data privacy requirements of leading law firms and in-house legal departments
- It complies with the requirements of applicable laws and regulations, including Singapore's PDPA and the EU's GDPR
- The data of Singapore users is hosted in Singapore, with data masking and access controls



What about upgrading, maintenance and troubleshooting?

- Automatic upgrades with maintenance and security patches



How much will it cost? Any grants available?

- The subscription cost of the LTP is S\$69 per user per month (before grant)
- Eligible Singapore law firms can apply for funding support under the LTPI Funding Programme, with support available for up to two years
